



Immunotherapy (Artuvetrin®) Schedule

Immunotherapy is the only treatment that targets the cause of allergies in pets rather than just controlling the clinical signs. It involves subcutaneous injections of small, gradually increasing amounts of allergens to desensitize the immune system, reducing the number and severity of flare-ups.

The treatment starts with a small 0.2 ml dose, increasing to a maximum of 1 ml over several weeks, followed by monthly (every 4 weeks) maintenance injections. Adjustments to the proposed schedule may be required based on the individual response of each pet.

If multiple vials are needed, injections from each vial should be given on the same day but at different sites.

Week 1	0.2 ml
2 weeks later (week 3)	0.4 ml
2 weeks later (week 5)	0.6 ml
2 weeks later (week 7)	0.8 ml
3 weeks later (week 10)	1.0 ml

Adjustment period	Dose
3 weeks later (week 13)	1.0 ml
4 weeks later (week 17)	1.0 ml
4 weeks later (week 21)	1.0 ml
Maintenance	
Every 4 weeks	1.0 ml
